Family Resource Centers (FRCS) - Listings will be found in the LIFESPAN SECTION

Family Resource Centers (FRC's) were established by legislation in 1995. The state is divided into 18 service areas with an FRC providing information, referrals, and case management to residents in each service area. FRC's collaborate with local and state agencies, as well as organizations to help individuals and families access needed services and support. Many FRC's also provide ESL, family literacy, and adult literacy programs or partner with agencies that do.

Family-to-Family Connections (F2F) - Listings will be found in the LIFESPAN SECTION

Family-to-Family Connections provides information, parenting classes, and support to families who have an infant, birth to 48 months. Programs provide information on child safety, health, development, education and other topics to help parents and other care givers provide the best environment possible during the first years of a child's life.

LIFT (Literacy Involves Families Together) Act 2000

The LIFT Act (Literacy Involves Families Together Act) of 2000 defines "family literacy services" as services provided to participants on a voluntary basis that are of sufficient intensity in terms of hours, and of sufficient duration, to make sustainable changes in a family, and that integrates all of the following activities: -Interactive literacy activities between parents and their children.

-Training and support for parents regarding how to be the primary teacher for their children and full partners in the education of their children.

-Parent literacy training that leads to economic self-sufficiency.

-An age-appropriate education to prepare children for success in school and life experiences

There are 96 separate public library buildings in 22 library jurisdictions in Nevada (supported by public funds). Public Libraries offer books, magazines, newspapers, DVD's, audio books, eBooks, and CD's for everyone in their communities. Children's programs, young adult programs, adult programs, reference, Internet access, word processors, and interlibrary loan are provided. Some public libraries in Nevada provide bookmobile services to remote areas.

UNIVERSITY OF NEVADA COOPERATIVE EXTENSION (UNCE)

Cooperative Extension is the outreach college of the Nevada University System. There are 19 Cooperative Extension offices throughout the state, each working with children and families. There are a variety of literacy programs serving all ages with an outreach which extends into homes, schools; childcare centers, and employment environments. The focus is on life-long learning.

OTHER

ACADEMIC LIBRARIES - Listings will be found in the ADULT SECTION

Academic libraries are community college, college, and university libraries that are part of educational institutions. The University of Nevada, Reno Knowledge Center and the University of Nevada, Las Vegas Lied Library are research libraries for their students and faculty with collections supporting programs taught or research done at the college or university level. Academic libraries are open to the public, but usually do not allow check out without a card. These libraries also offer a variety of databases for students and faculty.

Family Storyteller - A Collaborative Family Literacy Program

The "Family Storyteller" gets books into children's hands and helps parents learn to use the books effectively to improve their children's literacy skills. The program's main purpose is to provide workshops that improve the literacy skills of both parents and their children. The workshops are designed primarily for families with preschoolers and beginning readers. They help all families but are specifically designed for parents who may have limited language skills and few children's books at home. The workshop series includes six sessions during which families:

- Discuss and learn basic parent/child reading techniques, including previewing a book, using expression as they read, pointing to pictures and labeling, reviewing and retelling, having children predict, and linking the book to life.
- Watch a video that models critical parent-child reading techniques. (The videos were developed specifically for the project to show parents reading with young children and modeling the selected skills.
- The video segments also address common questions about the value and activity of reading with young children.)
- Practice reading, in which the facilitator first models how to read the book. (Parents then practice reading with each other, before finally reading the book to their children.)
- Learn about take-home activities that extend the learning from parent-child workshops into homes. (the take-home activities provide ideas that parents can use to enhance their children's literacy and language development materials include descriptions of activities plus all the supplies needed to do the activities at home.)
- Receive a free book and materials to complete the extender activities at home. Selected children's books featured in each workshop session include Goodnight Moon; The Very Hungry Caterpillar; Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What Do You See?; Peter's Chair; The Wheels On The Bus; and Have You Seen My Duckling?;
- The program is available in English and in Spanish.

Public Libraries offer books, magazines, newspapers, DVD's, audio books, eBooks, and CD's for everyone in their communities. Children's programs, young adult programs, adult programs, reference, Internet access, word processors, and interlibrary loan are provided. Some public libraries in Nevada provide bookmobile services to remote areas.

Statewide Reading Programs

Summer Reading and Year-Around Reading Programs

These programs offer themed reading activities during summer or other school breaks. They target young children and youth with developmentally appropriate reading and follow-up activities that encourage reading. The purpose is two-fold, to help to foster a love of books and reading and help students retain their reading levels during breaks from school.

•El Día de los Niños – El Día de los Libros – In English, Day of the Children – Day of the Books is a family literacy activity focusing on Hispanic literature and culture, as well as appreciation for cultural and linguistic diversity. Held in April, participating libraries hold special events that encourage other cultures to visit their local libraries. The goal is that non-library users become library card holders and users, as well as participants in other library activities. Further, the activities are intended to encourage all Nevadans to learn more about other cultures, appreciate diversity, and break down cultural barriers.

Nevada Reading Week – Held in March, Nevada Reading Week is a series of activities promoted by school and public libraries geared toward fostering family reading. Each school and community library determines its own activities with support from an annual themed manual provided to libraries statewide.
